## Declaration

I certify that the information on my application is correct and agree to keep it updated as necessary. I understand that by becoming a crewmember/participant of this excavation/program, I am subject to the rules and regulations regarding conduct, scholarship, scientific integrity and full participation in the excavation/program workday. I understand that if I am in violation of these rules and regulations, I will be asked to leave the excavation/program without refund of my money and forfeit my place as a member of the excavation crew/program participant. Moreover, I am expected to abide by the national laws of Portugal as they apply to foreigners who reside in their country in the capacity of either a tourist or a student work or travel visa.

I understand that illegal drugs in any form are not tolerated. Laws state that the purchase, possession or use of illegal drugs is punishable by fine, imprisonment and/or deportation. I understand that crewmembers at this excavation/program found buying, using or possessing illegal drugs in any form are subject to immediate expulsion. The legal drinking age of alcohol in Portugal is over the age of 16. Alcoholic drinks are not considered illegal drugs. However, crewmembers/participants are not allowed to work on site/in the lab while inebriated or under the influence of alcohol.

I understand that the use of any scientific information or research gathered during my involvement in a PortAnta program or excavation can not be used for publications, thesis or papers in any form without the express consent of the responsible researcher and a formal contract being signed between the two parties outlining the ways in which said material can be used. If a participant or student uses said information in an unethical manner, PortAnta reserves the right to pursue the recovery of this information or the removal of it from any publication. All information shared with participants is done so in the spirit of good faith and the breach of this good faith, by both parties, is not tolerated in any manner. If students wish to utilize any part of the work that they engage in while work with PortAnta, they are encouraged to discuss the possibilities of a collaborative work and in most cases, their requests are granted when possible. In addition, no film footage of work conducted on site or in a program can be posted or circulated without the express permission of PortAnta or those individuals being filmed. Photographs, images or drawings of any kind can not be reproduced for publication without the express permission of PortAnta and when permission is granted, in a case when scientific material is represented, the PortAnta copyright must be labelled on the item. This clause should be applied with good sense – personal photographs and images of research can be used for educational purposes and for personal use and not for commercial or financial profit. In short, just ask.

I understand that racist, sexist, degrading and disrespectful behaviour towards the directors, instructors and participants of any of the programs of PortAnta will not be tolerated in any form or on any level. I understand that should my behaviour or conduct towards individuals become intolerable or should it lead to the disruption of a program or excavation, I will be asked to leave the program/excavation at my own expense. This rule is enforced because PortAnta believes that all members of the cooperative and all participants should be treated fairly and respectfully and that all malicious behaviour, in any degree, is intolerable.

I understand that neither Maia Langley nor any member of the PortAnta organization cannot be held responsible for any injuries, loss or damage to my person or property. I agree to fully indemnify and hold Maia Langley and any member of the PortAnta organization harmless for any and all claims that might be brought against them regarding my involvement as a crewmember/participant, including the payment of any reasonable legal fees. I understand and agree that any disputes will be governed by the substantive laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

I accept final responsibility for fees associated with the program and understand that if I do not pay a security deposit (half the full amount) by the 31<sup>st</sup> of March, I will forfeit my place as a crewmember on the excavation/participant in the program. The total amount of the tuition is due by the 30<sup>th</sup> of May.

I also understand that I must fill out all forms provided by the directors in order to assure my place as a crewmember/participant. I understand that should I voluntarily forfeit my place on the excavation/program, I will not receive a reimbursement of my security deposit. (This is enforced only because the directors may have to assume certain financial responsibilities for the crewmember's/participant's late cancellation.) Should the directors cancel the excavation/program, a full reimbursement will be issued to the crewmembers/participants. The sender will absorb any fees involved in transferring the monies. This is enforced only because the directors may have to assume certain financial responsibilities for the crewmember's/participant's late cancellation.
